In your email dated 24 June 2024, you directed candidates for the NIAG Industrial Interface Group to NFTE (NIIFTE) leadership team to answer, in no more than 200 words, three questions:

- 1. Why are you the ideal candidate?
- 2. What would you aim to achieve in the first 18 months?
- 3. What do you sense is the greatest risk to NFTE?

Please see my response below:

I believe that I would bring an unrivalled level of knowledge and experience around military flying training to the NIIFTE. I have extensive instructional experience, have commanded a training squadron, have commanded the Central Flying School, responsible for training all military flying instructors, and as the Director of Flying Training (1* officer) I was responsible for delivering all UK military flying training. I also bring expertise as a Business Development Director and Managing Director within a high-tech training company.

I have extensive experience of operating alongside NATO allies, both in the cockpit and in the headquarters environment. I am collaborative, an excellent communicator and have a proven track record of building focused, motivated and highly effective teams.

The majority of NFTE signatory nations are already experiencing a shortfall in their sovereign pilot training capacity. Therefore, I believe the greatest risk to NFTE is that the programme proceeds too slowly. With that in mind, in the first 18 months I would operate 'at pace' by establishing the NIIFTE as a fully functioning and collaborative body with a clear battle rhythm. That will enable us to start providing advice on existing solutions, technological developments and potential research projects at the earliest opportunity.
